2025 Tariff Price Adjustment

Due to the recent tariffs, Bradley will be implementing a <u>5% average</u> increase of list prices across all product lines effective <u>March 31, 2025.</u>

We will provide a summary of each product line increase as soon as possible.

Please pay close attention to the following information on price book availability, new orders, and quotes.

Availability of Price Books: All books will be available on Bradley's AnswerNET* website by the following dates.	February 27, 2025
New Orders reflecting old pricing must be received before the following dates.	March 28, 2025
New orders need to have a requested ship date of no later than the following dates unless scheduled to standard lead times.	April 11, 2025
All other orders already in-house pending release must be released by the following dates and will be entered into our build schedule for delivery based on standard lead times.	March 28, 2025

Bradley reserves the right to reject any order sent in with a quote date older than the period stated above unless prior arrangements have been approved. We also reserve the right to incorporate new pricing for quotes that may fall within the period stated above if significant changes are made to the layout or design including material selection.

The sales representative organization is responsible for communicating 2025 pricing to their respective customers.
